

Let's get this party started!

1. **Get the Reading plan.** In order for everyone to be on the same schedule each day, use this [reading plan](#). This is the Blue Letter Bible One Year Chronological Reading Plan. Other chronological reading plans or Bibles may be slightly different. Each day you will read an average of 3 chapters. This can be done in just 12 minutes per day. After reading the passage, think about what it says about God. Identify your "Glimpse of God"- one thing that you notice that the text says about God, Jesus, or the Holy Spirit. Write down this truth and meditate on it throughout the day.

For digital users:

A. Download the [Bible app](#).

STOP!: In order to be on the same schedule with everyone else, don't set up this reading plan on the Bible app until Jan 1. The plan begins the day you set it up.

2. **Want a helpful resource?** Subscribe to the Bible Recap podcast, a daily podcast to listen to after reading the scripture passage. The podcast is approximately 8 min long per day. This resource will add cultural and historical context to aid in understanding the passage. It also helps identify what the text says about God as Tara-Leigh Cobble shares her glimpse of God (God Shot) each day.
