Basics

Basic Details

- Gender
- Birth Date, Phone Number, Address

Estate Planning Options

- Are you legally married? (Yes/No)
 - →Yes
 - What is your spouse's name?
 - You will be given the option to create a Mirror Will for your spouse at the Review stage of the will-making process.
- What type of estate planning document do you want to make?
 - *California residents tend to choose a Revocable Living Trust

Trust Details

- Do you want to update an existing trust that you already have? (Yes/No)
 - →Yes
 - You will be asked the Full Name of the existing trust and the Execution Date of the existing trust
- What would you like to name your trust?



Nominees

Children and Guardianship Minors

- Do you have any children? (Yes/No)
 - →Yes
 - What are the full legal names of your children?
 - Are any of your children under the age of 18?
 - →Yes
 - In order of preference, who would you like to be the child's guardian if your minor child were left parentless when you pass away?

Pet Care and Pet Care Takers

- Do you have any pets you would like to provide for in your trust? (Yes/No)
 - →Yes
 - Please enter a name and description (eg: Felix the black cat), and species for each pet:*
 - How much money would you like to provide for your pets' needs (food, veterinary costs, etc)?*
 - In order of preference, who should be responsible for taking care of your pets if you pass away?
