

T&T (Truth & Training) Parent Information

Section Components:

- 1) **Start Here**-An activity designed as a warm up for the lesson (that will be taught during the teaching time).
- 2) **Explore**-The core Bible study content.
- 3) **Memorize**-The memory verse and definitions.
- 4) **Review**-Reviews the previous section's verses.

Listening to Sections:

Please read the two pages in the handbook for parents. Then work together with your child to help them complete each section. Each section offers a "memory tip" to help your child learn the memory verse. Keep a version of the Bible that your child is using at home so that they can complete the "explore" Bible study. You can go to hbclynchburg.com/awana to view the pacing guide (if you would like your child to complete their handbook before the May award ceremony), for downloadable audio versions of the verses to assist with memorization, and for more details in the Hearing Sections Guidelines. There is an award for book completion.

Leaders will verify that each child's section, with the four components, is completed. This means that leaders will need to listen to verses being quoted correctly (giving two helps or less). The goal is for these sections to be signed off by the leader before club begins or during the first few minutes of **Small Group Time**. Sections may also be listened to at another time and place convenient for the child and leader to meet.

Awards:

The awards emblems will be given out for every **four sections** completed. Most children will complete the sections in the book in consecutive order. But, an exception can be made for the infrequent attender that allows them to receive an award for every four sections finished on a cumulative basis.

Optional Material:

The handbook contains optional extra credit sections; Silver for Bible studies and Gold for memory verses. These sections can be done at any time throughout the year. There is an award given for completing all of these extra credit sections. Your child can also choose to do the Mission Update to learn about other countries and to pray for the people of that country.

Review Section Modification

At the end of each section there is a major review of the verses that include every verse memorized in that section (6-10 verses). To keep this doable for every child, this section may be divided into two parts so that the **child will only have to quote half the verses** each time, with the usual "two helps".
